Operator Slewing Mobile Crane up to 20T - National	Can operate a slewing mobile crane with a maximum rated capacity (MRC) up to 20 tonnes * Will also require a High Risk Work Licence issued by Government or industry organisation	X	
Operator Slewing Mobile Crane up to 60T - National	Can operate a slewing mobile crane with a maximum rated capacity (MRC) up to 60 tonnes * Will also require a High Risk Work Licence issued by Government or industry organisation	X	
Roller Operator - National	Can operate a roller to compact material		X
Scraper Operator - National	Can operate a scraper to load, haul and dump materials		X
Spreader Operator - National	Can operate, relocate and carrying out operator maintenance on a spreader		X

Telehandler Non-Slewing crane above 3T - National	Can operate telescopic materials handler mobile crane of greater than 3 tonnes capacity including attaching, securing, lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the telescopic materials handler; and carry out machine operator maintenance * Will also require a High Risk Work Licence issued by Government or industry organisation	X	
Telehandler Slewing crane above 3T - National	Can operate telescopic materials handler slewing mobile crane of greater than 3 tonnes capacity including attaching, securing, lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the telescopic materials handler; and carry out machine operator maintenance * Will also require a High Risk Work Licence issued by Government or industry organisation	X	
Telehandler under 3T - National	Can operate telescopic materials handler mobile crane of less than 3 tonnes capacity including attaching, securing, lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocating the telescopic materials handler; and carry out machine operator maintenance		X
Tip Truck - National	This is a similar description to a Dump truck but is generally used for longer hauls outside of the work site and therefore road registered		X
Tractor Operator - National	Can operate tractors and use attachments		X
Asphalt Paver Operator - National	An asphalt paver is the machine that lays the asphalt		X
Belly Dump Truck Operator - National	A belly dump driver drives and operates a belly dump truck This vehicle has a double bottom, and the material in the trailer dumps from the bottom rather than from the end, as it would with an end dump truck		X
Bolter - National	Install primary ground support in civil construction This includes setting out points of support, installing sets and rings, sheet piling and panel and box sets, as well as performing maintenance on primary ground support through inspections, fault identification and implementing adjustments		X
Bus Driver - Mini (up to 12 seats) - National	Can operate mini bus with up to 12 seats		X
Bus Driver (over 12 seats) - National	Can operate bus with over 12 seats		X
Crusher Operator - National	Can operator a Crusher Crusher to crush, grind, or polish materials, such as coal, glass, grain, stone, food, or rubber		X
National - CD - Derrick Crane Operator	A derrick crane is a slewing strut-boom crane with the boom pivoted at the base of a mast which is either guyed (guy-derrick) or held by backstays (stiff-leg derrick) and which is capable of luffing under load	X	
CP - Portal Boom Crane Operator - National	A portal boom crane is a boom crane or jib crane mounted on a portal frame, which is supported on runways along which the crane may travel	X	
CS - Self Erecting Tower Crane - National	A self-erecting tower crane is a type of crane with tower and boom/jib elements that do not dismantle into component sections Self-erecting tower cranes can be transported between sites as a complete unit The erection and dismantling process is a fundamental part of the cranes function	X	
CT - Tower Crane - National	A tower crane is a jib or boom crane mounted on a tower structure, demountable or permanent, including both horizontal and luffing jib types	X	
CV - Vehicle Loading Crane - National	Can Operate a vehicle loading crane with a capacity of 10 metre tonnes or more	X	
HP - Hoists (Personnel and Materials) - National	A materials or personnel hoist is used to hoist personnel, goods and/or materials It comprises a car, structure, machinery or other equipment associated with the hoist, and may be either a cantilever hoist, tower hoist or a multiple winch operation	X	
HM - Materials Hoist (Cantilever Platform) - National	A materials hoist is used to hoist goods or materials only, not personnel The car, bucket or platform is cantilevered from, and travels up and down externally, to a face of the support structure	X	
Kerb & Channel Machine Operator - National	Drives and operates curbing machine to extrude concrete and asphalt curbing		X
Reach Stacker - National	The reach stacker licence covers powered reach stackers (with a capacity of three tonnes or more) that have an attachment for lifting, lowering, moving and travelling with a shipping container	X	
Road Paver Operator - National	A paver operator uses specialized machines to spread asphalt over a surface		X
Truck Driver Concrete Agitator - National	Concrete Agitator Truck Driver is responsible for the safe and efficient loading, delivery and unloading of concrete		X
Truck Driver Fuel Tanker - National	As a fuel tanker truck driver, you transport gas or other petroleum products		X
Truck Driver Heavy Combination - National	Heavy Combination (HC class) heavy vehicle licences allow you to drive: Prime movers with attached single semi-trailer		X
Truck Driver Heavy Rigid - National	A motor vehicle that has a gross vehicle mass (GVM) more than 8 tonnes and has 3 or more axles (whether or not the wheels on those axles are on the road) or, a bus consisting of more than one rigid section which are connected to one another so as to allow rotary movement and passenger access between the sections		X
Truck Driver Light Rigid - National	Has a gross vehicle mass (GVM) more than 45 tonnes but not more than 8 tonnes or seats more than 12 adults (including the driver) and has a GVM not more than 8 tonnes		X
Truck Driver Medium Rigid - National	Has a gross vehicle mass (GVM) more than 8 tonnes and has no more than 2 axles		X
Truck Driver Multi Combination - National	Is any motor vehicle or combination of vehicles other than a motor cycle		X
Vacuum Truck Operator - National	Responsible for transporting, loading and offloading of fluids at different locations		X
Water Cart Operator - National	Water Cart Operators drive heavy vehicles that haul and spray fluids Water carts are used to suppress dust on job sites, clean pavements and prepare unsealed roads for grading and sealing		X
