Around The Track Personnel (Construction/Maintenance)		This role is used for the following types of workers in the rail corridor: Graffiti Removal, General Civil Labouring / Maintenance activities outside the Danger Zone (equivalent to the general civil construction labourer), Apprentices/Trainees, Engineers/Project Managers etc required to access the rail corridor (they must also hold their Engineering/Project Managers RIW role), Surveyors, Tractor Operators, Truck Drivers and Water Cart Operators.
