<b>Role Definitions</b>					
<b>Dump Truck - NSW</b> A dump truck operator drives large trucks that transport and dump waste materials like sand, gravel, rock or non-degradable garbage. a large truck for transporting heavy loads, with a back part that can be raised at one end so that its contents fall out, whereas a side dump truck (SDT) consists of a 3-axle tractor pulling a 2-axle semi-trailer. It has hydraulic rams which tilt the dump body onto its side, spilling the material to either the left or right side of the trailer. Dump Truck - NSW, Does the same work as a Dump Truck driver, however may work on a restricted licence as per the requirements of NSW regulator Safework					
<b>Rail Bound Plant Operator - National</b> Track maintenance machines or items of plant which under normal conditions cannot be removed from the track					
<b>Rail Bound Plant Operator Light - National</b> Can operate light self-propelled on-track vehicle on a rail network					
<b>Rail Bound Plant Operator Medium/Heavy - National</b> Can operate medium or heavy self-propelled on-track vehicle on a rail network.					
<b>Road-Rail Plant Operator - National</b> A rolling stock vehicle which can operate under its own power, both on and off rail, and which can transition from one mode of operation to the other. Road rail vehicles may or may not have the ability to travel on a public highway, and may or may not be road registered.
