

Role Descriptors	
Auto Electrician - National	An auto electrician is a tradesperson specialising in electrical wiring of motor vehicles Auto electricians may be employed in the installation of new electrical components or the maintenance and repair of existing electrical components
Boilermaker - National	A boilermaker is a qualified tradesperson in which the primary work is to produce steel fabrications from plates and tubes, along with providing specialist welding services
Bricklayer - National	A bricklayer is a qualified tradesperson who lays bricks to construct brickwork
Carpenter - National	Carpentry is a qualified trade in which the primary work performed is the cutting, shaping and installation of building materials during the construction of buildings, timber bridges, concrete formwork, etc
Electrician - National	Installs, tests, connects, commissions, maintains and modifies electrical equipment, wiring and control systems Registration or licensing is required
Electronic Trades - National	Electronics technicians help design, develop, test, manufacture, install, and repair electrical and electronic equipment such as communication equipment, medical monitoring devices, navigational equipment, and computers They may be employed in product evaluation and testing, using measuring and diagnostic devices to adjust, test, and repair equipment
Site plant repairer/maintainer - National	A plant repairer/maintainer is a person whose job is to assemble, adjust, repair, maintain or install machinery or equipment
Formworker - National	A qualified person who constructs temporary or permanent moulds into which concrete or similar materials are poured
Mechanic - National	A mechanic is a qualified tradesperson who performs mechanical work on mobile vehicles and plant
Plumber - National	A plumber is responsible for installing, repairing and maintaining pipes, fixtures and other plumbing used for water distribution and waste water disposal in commercial and residential
Refrigeration - National	Refrigeration Technicians, commonly known as Refrigeration Mechanics, repair, install and troubleshoot refrigeration systems They can work on industrial or residential climate-control systems, such as HVAC units and refrigerated storage units
Rigger - National	A dogman or rigger specialises in the lifting/moving of large and heavy pipes and equipment They must work together to ensure the slings are safely placed on the equipment to be lifted and that the slings are loaded onto the crane's hooking correctly A dogman or rigger then directs the crane operator by either radio or hand signals to advise him when the load can be lifted and moved Although not a physically demanding role, they are required to work on uneven ground and are constantly looking overhead watching the crane's hook
Scaffolder - National	Scaffolders erect, alter and dismantle temporary scaffolding structures that provide work platforms and stairway access to building sites
Sheet Metal Worker - National	A sheet metal worker is a qualified tradesperson who creates, installs, and repairs sheet metal products
Steel Fixer - National	Steel fixers position and assemble steel bars and mesh sheeting with ligatures to form reinforcement for concrete structures such as concrete slabs, columns, drainage and communication pits, walls and concrete barrier structures Steel fixing is the mould created prior to pouring the concrete
Abrasive Blaster - National	Abrasive blasting is using pressurized air or water to propel abrasive media against a surface to remove coating, corrosion, or contamination
Arborist - National	Arborists specialise in the care of trees
Asbestos Removalist	There are two types of licences for asbestos removal – Class A and Class B Class B licence holders are only permitted to perform Class B asbestos removal work, which means asbestos removal work (other than limited asbestos removal work) involving the removal of: non-friable asbestos, or asbestos-contaminated dust associated with or derived from the removal of non-friable asbestos Class A licence-holders are permitted to perform Class B and Class A asbestos removal work, which means asbestos removal work (other than limited asbestos removal work) involving the removal of: friable asbestos, or asbestos-contaminated dust (other than asbestos-contaminated dust associated with or derived from the removal of non-friable asbestos)
Belt Technician - National	Conveyor Belt Technicians work with a range of machinery and polymer materials, including rubber, polyurethanes and HDPE Their work involves keeping conveyor belt systems operating
Civil Labourer - National	Civil Construction Workers work on civil construction and infrastructure projects performing a variety of physical task for example, shovelling, digging, graffiti Removal, General Civil Labouring/ Maintenance activities
Cleaner - National	A person employed to help maintain clean facilities and living areas, crib sheds etc for workers and public
Communication Technician - National	Communication technicians install, maintain, test and repair wiring or cable networks, as well as consumer or business communication equipment
Concreter	Pours, spreads, smooths and finishes concrete for structures such as floors, stairs, ramps, footpaths and bridges
Confined Space Worker - National	A 'confined space' is defined as an enclosed or partially enclosed space that: is not designed to be occupied by a person, and is intended to be at normal atmospheric pressure while any person is in the space, and is or is likely to be a risk to health and safety from an unsafe oxygen level, or contaminants, including airborne gases, vapours and dusts, that may cause injury from fire or explosion, or harmful concentrations of any airborne contaminants, or engulfment
Demolition Worker - National	Demolition workers demolish, dismantle and remove building structures and materials including brick, timber, concrete and metal
Driller Offsider - National	A Driller's Offsider, or a Driller's Assistant, is someone who helps to set up and operate drilling rigs
Drug Testing Officer - National	The Drug and Alcohol Testing (DAT) Officer is responsible for administering drug and alcohol tests on specified employees in accordance with relevant legislation and departmental policy
Fencing Contractor - National	position wooden, concrete or metal posts and fix them to a base cut panels to size and fix them to the posts apply finishes like paint, staining and weatherproofing repair fences and gates
Fire Protection Worker - National	Fire protection officers examine buildings to detect fire hazards and ensure that fire codes are met They also commission, install, and maintain fire protection systems and equipment in buildings and other facilities

Fire Warden - National	The fire warden is often responsible for testing fire alarms and firefighting equipment and implementing risk assessment recommendations If there's a fire, the fire warden should assist the fire marshal with the evacuation of the building
First Aid Officer - National	A First Aid Officer is responsible for monitoring and maintaining first aid facilities in their office, administering first aid and assisting the WHS Site Officer (where the WHS Site Officer is not also the First Aid Officer), in monitoring and reporting WHS risks and incidents
Fitter (Hydraulic) - National	A Hydraulic Fitter produces and fits parts for hydraulic equipment
Foreman - National	The Foreman is responsible for scheduling, co-ordinating and supervising the work of all site operatives, ensuring that all work is delivered safely on time and within budget along with managing equipment and materials required
Gardener - National	Gardeners plant and maintain gardens or other natural landscaping
Gas Fitter - National	Gas fitters install, inspect, repair and maintain gas lines and gas equipment
Glazier - National	A glazier is a tradesman who works with glass and glass substitutes Tasked with cutting, installing and removing glass of all kinds, glaziers install glass into things such as windows, doors, displays, storefronts and skylights, among other things
Leading Hand - National	A Leading Hand is an experienced and specialist worker responsible for certain employees or processes with limited supervision from management Leading Hands are usually found in construction, building, telecommunications, production and manufacturing environments
Landscaper - National	A landscaper designs, creates, and maintains outdoor spaces such as gardens, lawns, and parks
Line Marker - National	Linemakers operate plants to apply markings to roads and other surfaces such as car parks, airports and sportsgrounds
Painter - National	Painters apply paint, stain, and coatings to walls and ceilings, buildings, large machinery and equipment, and bridges and other structures
Pipelayer (Qualified) - National	A pipelayer (or pipe-layer or drain layer) is a skilled tradesman who lays pipe, such as for storm sewers, sanitary sewers, drains, and water mains
Plasterer - National	A plasterer is a tradesman or tradesperson who works with plaster, such as forming a layer of plaster on an interior wall or plaster decorative mouldings on ceilings or walls
Roof Cladder - National	A roof sheeter or cladder fixes large weatherproof sheets of different material to roofs (sheeting) or walls (cladding)
Security Officer / Guard - National	Security Officers and Guards provide security and investigative services to organisations and individuals Tasks may include patrolling property and checking doors, windows and gates for unauthorised entry watching for irregularities
Spotter - National	A spotter stand near the equipment or vehicle and feed information to the driver, including directions and things the driver is unable to see or hear by themselves
Storeperson - National	Storeperson receive, handle and dispatch goods and products coming into, or going out of, stockrooms, stores or warehouses
Surveyor - National	A surveyor is a professional who is responsible for measuring and mapping different types of land and properties They use specialized tools and equipment to collect data and create precise representations of the land and property boundaries
Traffic Controller	Road traffic controllers direct vehicle and pedestrian traffic in an organised way to ensure public safety at construction zones, accidents, public events or other road disruptions Using signs and other devices, they manage the movements of emergency response teams, construction workers and the general public
Waterproofer - National	Waterproofers are responsible for applying sealants, coatings and other materials to surfaces in order to prevent water from penetrating and causing damage
Welder - National	Welding is a fabrication process that joins materials, usually metals or thermoplastics, by using high heat to melt the parts together and allowing them to cool, causing fusion
Welder - Poly Pipe - National	Poly welding is the process of joining thermoplastic polymers, which can be done by butt welding, electrofusion and extrusion welding
Yardman - National	a person working in a railway or timber yard
