Electrical Networks Competency Matrix Update V4

Purpose

MTM Electrical Networks Competency Matrix

The purpose of this bulletin is to advise MTM employees and Third Parties of the requirement to comply with the changes to the MTM Electrical Networks matrix.

This document is applicable to contractors, third parties, as well as MTM employees who require to hold RIW cards, who are working on or near to MTM network and premises.

What are the changes?

The following paragraphs list the roles within the RIW System. RIW Cardholders should refer to the following link for further information on the revised MTM Electrical Networks Version 4 matrix and role requirements.

Amendment record:

The below sections have been updated on the matrix which consists of:

MTM – Permit to Work

 As of the 26th August 2023 all MTM – Permit to Work holders must comply with the new mandatory competency requirement of Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). If you do not comply with the new requirement your job role will become invalid, and you will not be able to work as a Permit to work holder on the MTM Network.

MTM - Lineworker 1 & MTM - Lineworker 2

If you are utilising an Elevated Work Platform >11m, whilst working as a Lineworker 1 or Lineworker 2, you must add the following Network Based competencies to your RIW profile.

- Statement of Attainment.MTM Perform EWP Controlled Descent Escape (66055)
- Statement of Attainment.MTM Perform EWP Rescue (66056)
- Statement of Attainment.MTM Perform Pole Top Rescue (66057)
- Note: All the above competencies have a validity of 12 months.

In addition to this, you must also hold the Elevated Work Platform Operator greater than 11M – National role on your RIW profile.





If you are utilising an Elevated Work Platform <11m, whilst working as a Lineworker 1 or Lineworker 2, you must add the following Network Based competencies to your RIW profile.

- Statement of Attainment.MTM Perform EWP Rescue (66056)
- o Statement of Attainment.MTM Perform Pole Top Rescue (66057)

Note: All the above competencies have a validity of 12 months

In addition to this, you must also hold the Elevated Work Platform Operator less than 11M – National role on your RIW profile.

Reminder as per RIW-BUL-03-2023

Any MTM - Overhead Safety Observer (OSO) working on the MTM network must hold a Rail Medical Category 1 and Provide First Aid in an ESI Environment. All RIW Cardholders must comply with the new requirements from **1 August 2023**. If you do not comply with the new requirement your job role will become invalid, and you will not be able to work as an Overhead Safety Observer on the network
